P+R: Bouillon, Stade, Kockelscheuer, Luxembourg-Sud (+ bus to the city centre)
The car parks "Schuman", "Bouillon", "Stade" and "Glacis" are free on Saturdays and Sundays.
For Kirchberg you can park on "Glacis" and walk over the Pont Rouge.

The main station is 10 minutes walk from the city centre.

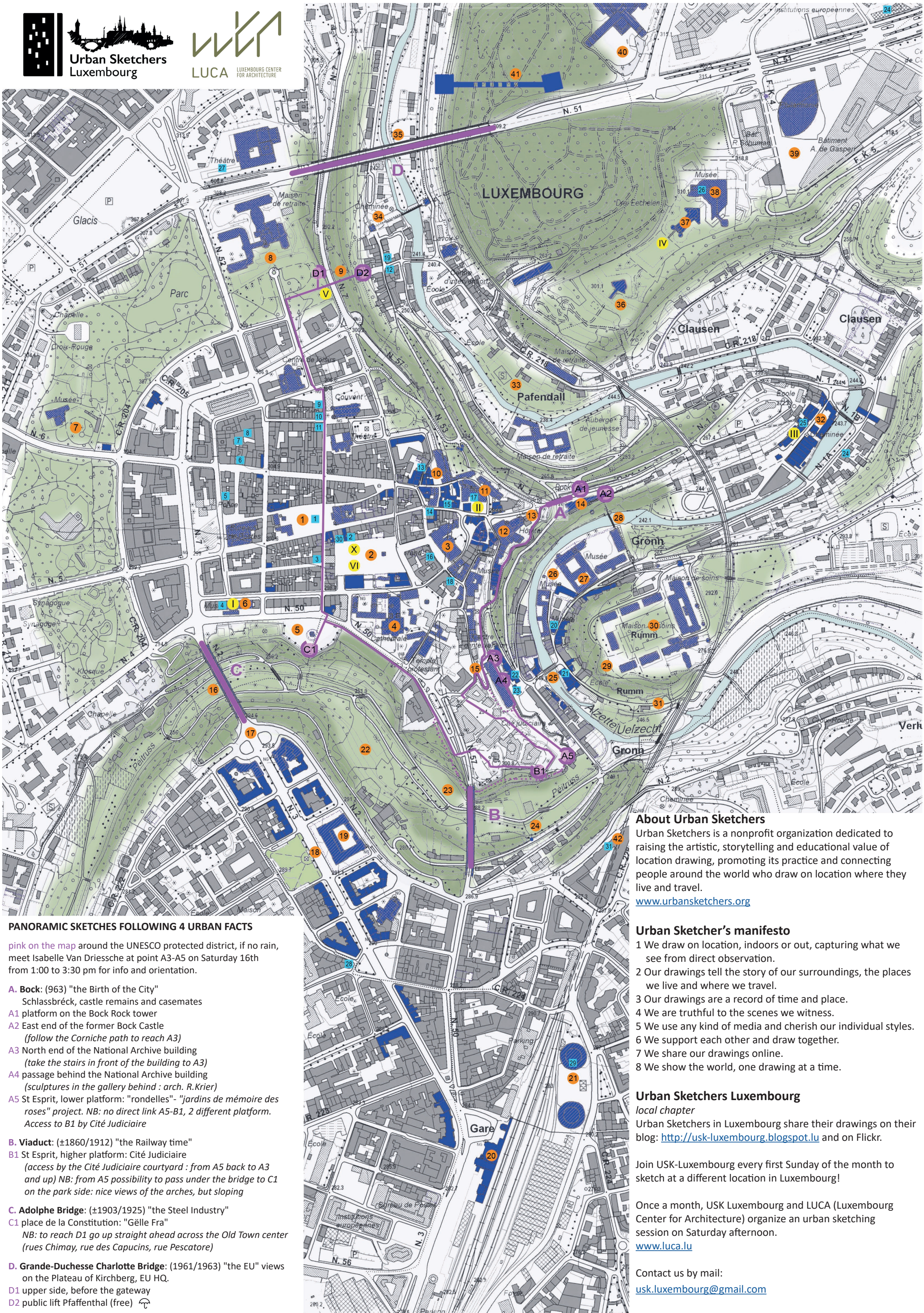
